- High school re-entry, designated hitter, and must-slide rules.
- Pro rule for intentional walks and appeals will be used.
- Games will be 7 innings, and the 10-run rule will be enforced.
- Umpires will be obtained from the St. Cloud Association.
- Be on time, so all games can go as scheduled; be prepared to agree to a mutual playable time in advance of your next scheduled game, in the event of rain.
- Dugouts assignments will be posted at the entrance by the ticket booth.
- Limit Infield/Outfield time to 10 minutes.
- Warm-up areas are available down the foul lines, outside the field of play; use the side according to dugout assignment.
- Fill out line-up cards and turn them in at scoring booth when you arrive.
- Game balls are provided for each game.
- Send a roster sheet by June 15<sup>th</sup>, so the program can be printed.
