## **Golden Eagle Baseball Signs Paul Myers (Arden Hills, Minn.) to a National Letter of Intent**

(Crookston, Minn.) – The University of Minnesota, Crookston Golden Eagle Baseball program announced today the signing of Paul Myers from Arden Hills, Minn., to a National Letter of Intent to play for the Golden Eagles during the 2009 season.

Myers is a 6'0, 170 lb, right-handed pitcher, from Mounds View High School of the Suburban East Conference. He was named All-Suburban East Conference Honorable Mention for the Mustangs in 2007. Myers will also pitch for perennial Minnesota American Legion Baseball powerhouse Tri-City Red of New Brighton this summer.

“One of our recruiting goals during this off-season is to add quality pitching depth, “says U of M, Crookston Head Coach Chris Vito. “Paul fits that role. He is an athletic player who will continue to improve. We are excited to have Paul become a part of the Golden Eagle Baseball program.”

Myers plans to major in Health Sciences (Pre-Professional) Pre-Medicine at the University of Minnesota, Crookston. He is the son of John Myers of Arden Hills, Minn. and Laura Myers of Arden Hills, Minn.
