TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Games:

Tournament Games shall consist of 7 innings. Due to field scheduling time constraints, no inning shall begin 2-1/2 hours from the time of the 1st pitch being thrown (Games considered complete). All game decisions made by Tournament Director are final.

Halted/Suspended Games/Inclement Weather:

All suspended games due to rain, darkness, curfew or field time restrictions, where 5 innings or more (4 ½ if the home team is ahead) have been completed, shall be declared an official game. Should the score be tied (5 completed innings or 4 ½ completed innings if the home team is ahead), a reasonable allotment of time shall be given to complete the game. Pool Play games can end in a tie game. In any of these events, the Tournament Director reserves the right to change, alter times, or cancel games as deemed necessary.

Mercy Rule:

Ten Run Mercy Rule applies after 4-1/2 innings (if Home team leads).

Designated Hitter:

A Designated Hitter is allowed for ANYONE in the line-up.

Re-Entry:

Re-Entry is allowed for players in the starting line-up only.

Determination of Home/Away:

A coin-flip will be conducted prior to each game to determine home teams for all games. The third base dugout is designated as the home team dugout, however, the Host Team Hopkins reserves the right to always occupy the third base dugout.

Courtesy Runners:

Courtesy Runners are allowed for both the Pitcher and Catcher, in the interest of expediting game times. Courtesy Runners can be players NOT currently in the Ballgame.

Rule Details:

The following rules shall be in effect throughout Tournament Play:

- NCAA Slide Rule
- Pro Walk
- Pro Balk
- Pro Appeal

Player/Coach Ejections:

In the event that a Player or Coach is ejected, they must leave the ballpark, and may not return while the game is in progress. Additionally, the ejected Player or Coach will not be allowed to participate in the following contest.

Batting Practice & Pre-Game Infield/Outfield:

Batting Cages are available at Hopkins High School (NO SPIKES), but NOT available at Concordia St. Paul. Pre-Game Infield/Outfield shall be taken by the Home team first (approximately 25-30 minutes prior to game time), followed by the Visiting Team (determinant upon field prep/time/conditions etc.).
