All other regular season American Legion rules apply.


The following criteria (in order) will be used to determine pool play finish: pool play record, head-to-head result, least runs allowed in all games, run differential in all games, coin flip.

- From I-80, west-bound from Des Moines, follow signs for North Omaha / Sioux City onto I-680
 West.
- Merge onto common I-29 South / I-680 West.
- Take exit 61B to merge onto I-680 W toward North Omaha.
- Take exit 4 for NE-64, toward Maple Street.
- Turn right onto NE-64 W / W Maple Road.
- Take the 1st right onto N 108th Street.
- Take the 2nd right onto Bedford Avenue.
- Slight right onto Old Maple Road.
- Old Maple Rd turns slightly left and becomes N 104th Avenue. Hotel will be on the left.




From Twin Cites Area to Creighton Prep High School (if driving straight to field):

- From I-80, west-bound from Des Moines, take exit 8 for US-6 toward Council Bluffs / Oakland.
- Slight right onto US-6 W / E Kanesville Blvd. (Continue to follow US-6 West.)
- Continue onto I-480 West (Entering Nebraska)
- Take exit 2B for 30th Street, toward Dodge Street.
- Turn right onto N 30th Street.
- Turn left onto Cuming Street.
- Slight right onto NE-64 West.
- Turn left onto Hamilton Street.
- Continue onto N Saddle Creek Road.
- At the traffic circle, take the 5th exit onto N Happy Hollow Blvd.
- Turn right onto Western Avenue.
- Turn left onto N 72nd Street.
- Take the 1st right onto Western Avenue.

Leg 1 (map at right): Exit 2B for 30th Street ... to traveling west on Cuming Street.




From LaQuinta Hotel to Creighton Prep field (about 4 miles, 10-15 minutes):
