Friday, June 27th:

By 8:00 am - Players are to be dropped off at Mounds View HS parking lot. The bus will depart at 8:15 am, after all gear is stowed. (It is recommended that players be *dropped off* at Mounds View, as opposed to leaving cars in the lot during the entire tournament). Players may also wish to bring along some breakfast food / snacks.

- Bring all jerseys and equipment. **Double and triple check!**
- It is suggested that parents driving to Fargo allow a minimum of 4-1/2 to 5 hours, due to the normal annoyance of summer road construction projects -- and depending upon how often you'd like to stop along the way.

At conclusion of these games, the bus will return to the hotel, so players can shower and change.

(We are planning a dinner excursion to a local restaurant thereafter, so that players can eat. All parents and family members are welcome also. We are planning to go to a restaurant that is within walking distance, but if we take the bus, parents are welcome to board the bus as well.)

12:00 midnight- Players to be in their respective rooms.

Sunday, June 29th:

8:45 am - Wake-up call. (Room inspection by coaches will follow, prior to check-out.)

10:00 am - After checking out of the hotel, the team will depart for Jack Williams Stadium.

11:30 am - Final pool play game against Chanhassen -- at Jack Williams Stadium.

Then, depending upon the team's performance in Pool Play ...

- 5:00 pm Championship Game at Jack Williams Stadium (against the Matson pool winner), with bus departing for Mounds View after conclusion of that game (with food excursion, on the way home) ... OR ...
- The bus will depart for Mounds View immediately following the 11:30 am game against Chanhassen.

Maps & Directions


From Twin Ciites Area to Jack Williams Stadium

(1200 Elm Street North, Fargo ND 58102)

Although there are several possible routes, this is Gail's preferred route:

- From I-94, prior to downtown exits for Moorhead, take the exit for 34th Street South. (Exit #2).
- At the top of the ramp, turn right onto 34th. In roughly 1/2 mile, turn left onto 24th Avenue South, to cut over to Main Avenue / County 52 / Business I-94.
- At the fork where 21st Street veers to the right, STAY TO THE LEFT TO STAY ON MAIN.
- After Main curves and you are heading westbound, turn right on 11th Street South.
- Continue northbound on 11th, crossing Highway 10, for roughly 1 mile.
- Turn left onto 15th Avenue North. (Matson Field will be on your left.)
- Continue across the toll bridge (very reasonable toll, perhaps \$.75-1.00) -- 15th Avenue North becomes 12th Avenue, after crossing the river.
- Jack Williams Stadium will be on your immediate left.

12th Ave North leads To I-29; Go south on I-29 to hotel exit (13th Ave SOUTH)



From Jack Williams Stadium to Days Inn, Approximately 15 minutes, 6 miles

(3431 14th Avenue South, Fargo, ND 58103, 701-235-5566)

- Head west on 12th Avenue North, about 3 miles, until reaching I-29.
- Take ramp onto I-29 South.
- Take exit 64 for 38th Street SW / 13th Ave South.
- Turn left onto 38th Street South.
- At light, turn left onto 13th Avenue South.
- After going underneath I-29, turn right onto 34th Street South.
- Then turn right onto 14th Avenue South. Hotel will be on the right. (Jack Williams Stadium)
