

Tri-City Red
2018 Fargo-Moorhead Invitational Tournament Itinerary

Friday, June 29th

Before 7:45 am - Players are to be dropped off at Mounds View HS parking lot. **The bus will depart at 8:00 a.m.**, after all gear is stowed. (It is recommended that players be *dropped off* at Mounds View, as opposed to leaving cars in the lot during the entire tournament). Players may also wish to bring along some breakfast food / snacks.

- Bring all jerseys, pants, hats and equipment. **Double and triple check!**
- Players should bring enough spending money for food, entertainment, shopping, etc.
- It is suggested that parents driving to Fargo allow 4+ hours, due to the normal annoyance of summer road construction projects -- and depending upon how often you plan to stop along the way.

The team bus will stop along the way to Fargo, so that players can buy food. Depending upon the timing of arrival in the Fargo area, the bus will either go to the hotel -- or it will go directly to the field (with players changing on the bus). Note: Anticipating that the bus will go to the hotel first, player rooms might not yet be available for check-in; if not, the team will need to use rest rooms or a side-room at the hotel to change into uniforms for its first game on Friday. The hotel has also indicated that if rooms are not yet fully available for check-in, they do not have space to store luggage; therefore, bags will need to be re-stowed on the bus.

3:00 pm - Game against COON RAPIDS -- at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

Following the game, the bus will return to the hotel so that players can complete check-in (if necessary), clean up, and quickly eat something.

Note: In addition to the games that are played at Jack Williams Stadium each day, games will also be played at Matson Field in Moorhead, which is directly across the Red River, to the west. It is recommended that parents and players check out the action at both fields while we are at the tournament -- which is part of the fun! Games will also be played at Young Field in West Fargo as well; see the maps (below) and full tournament schedule for games times at all three fields.

By 6:45 pm - Team bus departs for Jack Williams Stadium.

8:00 pm - Game against FARGO -- at Jack Williams Stadium.

Following the game, the bus will return to the hotel, players can shower, eat -- and rest, after a long day.

Midnight - Players are to be in their respective rooms for the rest of the night.

Saturday, June 30th

6:00 am (to 10:00 am) - Complimentary hot/cold breakfast is available at hotel.

By 7:45 am - Bus departs the hotel for Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

9:00 am - Game against ALEXANDRIA -- at Jack Williams Stadium.

11:30 pm - Game against WATERTOWN SD -- at Jack Williams Stadium.

In between the above two games, players will likely wish to buy food at the concession stand, which has very good food!

Following the games, the bus will return to the hotel, so players can shower, change and relax.

4:30 pm - Bus departs for a group meal within the Fargo area. All parents and family/friends are welcome to participate / board the bus -- or drive their own vehicles. The bus will return to the hotel afterwards.

Midnight - Players are to be in their respective rooms for the remainder of the night.

Sunday, July 1st

6:00 am (to 10:00 am) - Complimentary hot/cold breakfast is available at hotel.

Red's Sunday game time -- and field location (Jack Williams, Matson Field, or Young Field) -- will depend upon the outcome of games played in pool play on Friday and Saturday. Therefore, Sunday's exact schedule will be communicated to players and parents late Saturday night.

TBD am - Room inspections by coaches begin, prior to check-out.

TBD am - Bus departs the hotel.

- Depending upon the time of our first game (9 am, 11:30 am, or 2 pm), coaches will advise if players should dress for their next game in their rooms -- or if they will dress on the bus, depending upon whether or not the bus, following check-out, will first be stopping for fast food, the mall -- or at another place of interest -- before going to the ballpark.)
- Regardless of first game time, players need to be fully out of their rooms by 11:45 am -- and getting their gear / bags stowed onto the bus.

TBD* - Bus arrives at the designated field for Tri-City Red's game (9 am, 11:30 am, or 2 pm).

- Thereafter, the team will either be playing in the Championship Game at Jack Williams Stadium -- or the bus will depart for Mounds View High School.
- **4:30 pm - Championship Game** -- at Jack Williams Stadium, with bus departing for Mounds View immediately thereafter.

Additional Notes:

- Check the itinerary. Be on time for ALL departures.
- Remember you represent yourself, your family, your coaches, your community, and the Legion.
- Any calls from the hotel staff about problems with any room (including noise) will result in disciplinary action against the entire room. Players are responsible for what happens in their rooms.
- Have fun, enjoy the tournament and our visit to Fargo / Moorhead!

From Twin Cities DIRECTLY to Jack Williams Stadium (& Matson Field)

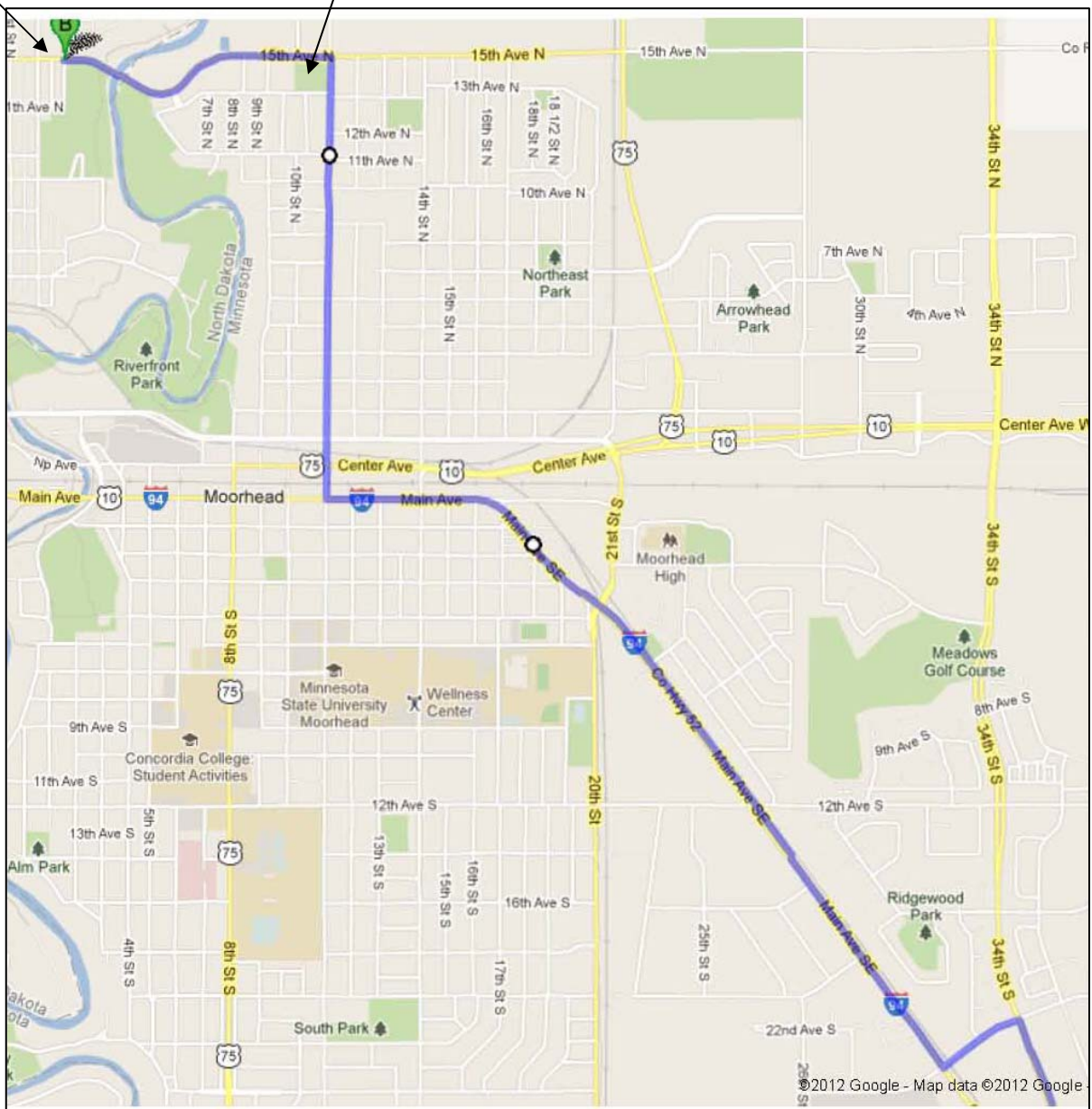
Matson Field: Intersection of 15th Avenue North (Hwy 83) & 11th Street, Moorhead, MN 56560

Jack Williams: 1200 Elm Street North; Intersection of Elm Street & 12th Avenue North, Fargo ND 58102

Although there are several possible routes, this is Gail's preferred route, directly to "Jack" or Matson from the Cities:

- From I-94, prior to downtown exits for Moorhead, take the exit for 34th Street South. (Exit #2).
- At the top of the ramp, turn right onto 34th. In roughly 1/2 mile, turn left onto 24th Avenue South, to cut over to Main Avenue / County 52 / Business I-94.
- At the fork where 21st Street veers to the right, **STAY TO THE LEFT TO STAY ON MAIN.**
- After Main curves and you are heading westbound, turn right on 11th Street South.
- Continue northbound on 11th, crossing Highway 10, for roughly 1 mile.
- Turn left onto 15th Avenue North. (**Matson Field** will be on your left.)
- To get to "Jack" and the hotel, continue across the bridge over the Red River (15th Avenue North becomes 12th Avenue, after crossing the river.)
- **Jack Williams Stadium** will be on your immediate left.

12th Ave North leads To I-29; Go south on I-29 to hotel exit (13th Ave SOUTH)

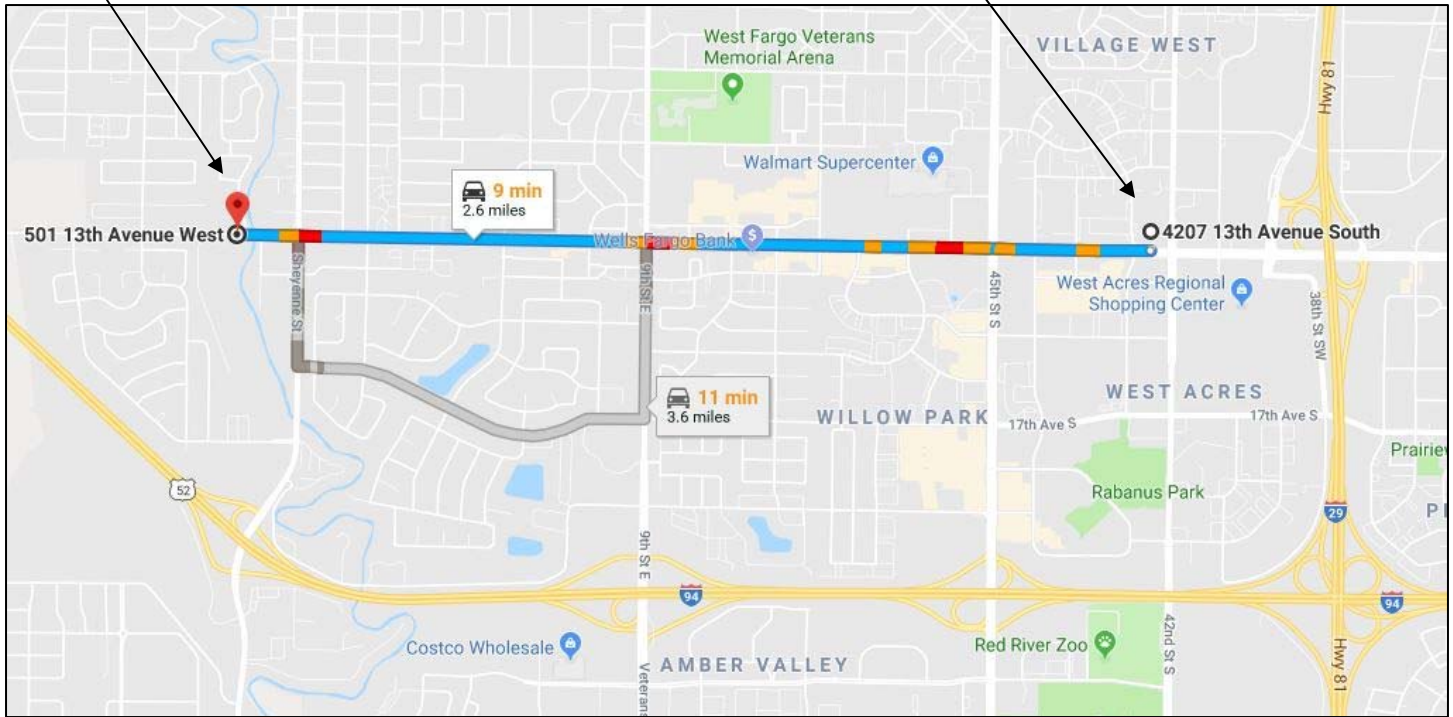
