(Each player will be provided with \$10 cash in meal money for the day, after the first game. Thus, on between games, players will likely wish to buy food at the concession stand, or parents might wish to pick up food at an outside establishment.)

5:00 pm - Pool-play game against SE TWINS (Saskatchewan) -- at Starion Field in Fargo.

Immediately following the game, all players must go to hotel (Days Inn, see above), to complete the team check-in process with Coach Bo and Gail.

8:30 am - 10:30 am - Players should eat breakfast and prepare to depart for first game. (Hotel might only be offering "grab-and-go" items in its breakfast nook, so allow for time to eat elsewhere, as desired!)

• As an additional option, each room is scheduled to have a microwave and a mini-refrigerator. Thus, it is recommended that players perhaps consider purchasing desired breakfast items at local establishments (for example, at nearby Hornbacher's Grocery Store) and refrigerating them overnight.

10:45 am - Room check by coaches, to ensure that all players are in the process of departing for the game site (car pool to caravan to the ball park).

11:00 am (or earlier, as instructed) - Players must be present at the ball park for our first game of the day.

Noon - Pool-play game against TEAM MANITOBA -- at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

(Each player will be provided with \$10 cash in meal money for the day, after the first game. Thus, on between games, players will likely wish to buy food at the concession stand, or parents might wish to pick up food at an outside establishment.)

3:30 pm - Pool-play game against FARGO POST 2 -- at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

Following the game, players return to the hotel to change, shower, etc. -- and enjoy free-time for the rest of the evening.

11:00 pm - Room check by coaches. Players are to be in their respective rooms for the rest of the night.

Saturday, July 2nd

The location and time of our first game (10:00 am or 12:30 pm) will depend upon our performance in Friday and Saturday pool-play games. Additionally, we likely won't know until after 9 pm on Saturday night, once all pool--play games have been completed. Thus, the following is recommended, anticipating that our first game will be at 10:00 am. If our game is at 12:30 pm on Saturday, the schedule below will be adjusted accordingly.

7:00 am - Players should eat breakfast and prepare to depart for first game.

By 8:15 am - Room inspection by coaches, who will also then check the team out of the hotel at the front desk. (<u>Players</u> should double and triple-check that they have packed all personal and team-related items, prior to check-out!)

By 8:45 am - All players must depart the hotel for the game site (car pools to caravan to the ball park).

9:00 am (or 11:30 am, if game is at 12:30 pm) - All players must be present at the field for our Saturday game (site to be announced the night before).

Clarifying Notes:

- If we win our pool -- or are in 2nd place -- we will play in a semi-final game at either 10:00 am or 12:30 pm.
- If we win our semi-final game, we will then play in the Championship game at 3:00 pm.
- If we are in 3rd, 4th, or 5th place in our pool, we will play only one game on Saturday (against a corresponding team from the other pool) -- at either 10:00 am or 12:30 pm.
- The site of Saturday's games will not be announced until Friday night, because host teams (Fargo Post 2, Fargo Post 400, West Fargo, and Moorhead) will be scheduled to play at their own home field -- for field maintenance purposes. For example, if we are paired to play against West Fargo on Saturday, we will most likely then play at Young Field (West Fargo's home field.) See schedule below for each host team's home field.

Following our final game on Saturday, car pools will depart for home.

Additional Notes:

- Check the itinerary. Be on time for ALL departures.
- Remember you represent yourself, your family, your coaches, your community, and the Legion.
- Any calls from the hotel staff about problems with any room (including noise) will result in disciplinary action against the entire room. Players are responsible for what happens in their rooms.
- There WILL be a gate fee for parents / spectators at each field. We are unsure, however, if they will be selling daily and/or full-tournament passes.
- We cannot guarantee that gate and/or concession stands will be accepting credit / debit cards. As such, please plan accordingly with respect to cash-on-hand!
