Friday, June 30th

BY 8:30 am, or earlier! - (recommended departure time by each carpool)

- ♦ **Bring all jerseys, pants, hats and equipment. Double and triple check! BRING BUG SPRAY ALSO!**
- ♦ Players should bring enough spending money for food, entertainment, shopping, etc.
- ♦ It is suggested that everyone who is driving to Fargo allow a good 4-5 hours, due to the normal annoyance of summer road construction projects -- and depending upon how often you plan to stop along the way.

8:30 am - 10:30 am - Players should eat breakfast and prepare to depart for first game. (Hotel might only be offering "grab-and-go" items in its breakfast nook, so allow for time to eat elsewhere, as desired!)

- ♦ As an additional option, each room is scheduled to have a microwave and a mini-refrigerator. Thus, players could also purchase desired breakfast items at local establishments (for example, at nearby Hornbacher's Grocery Store) and refrigerating them overnight.

10:30 am - Room check by coaches, to ensure that all players are in the process of departing for the game site (car pools will then caravan to the ball park).

11:00 am (or earlier, as instructed) - Players must be present at the ball park for our first game of the day.

Noon - Pool-play game against WAYZATA (#2 team) -- at Matson Field in Moorhead.

("Jack" is directly across the Red River from Matson Field in Moorhead; simply turn left / west onto **15th Avenue**, when leaving the north end of the Matson parking lot! .. 15th Avenue N becomes 12th Avenue N, on the ND side of the river.)

5:00 pm - Pool-play game against FARGO POST 2 -- at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

Following the game, players return to the hotel to change, shower, etc. -- and enjoy free-time for the rest of the evening.

11:00 pm - Room check by coaches. Players are to be in their respective rooms for the rest of the night.

Sunday, July 2nd

7:00 am - 8:15 am - Players should eat breakfast, PACK UP ALL BELONGINGS and prepare for check-out -- and departure for final game(s).

8:15 - 8:30 am - Room check by coaches, to ensure that all players are in the process of departing for the game site (car pools will then caravan to the ball park).

9:00 am (or earlier, as instructed) - Players must be present at the ball park for our first game of the day.

10:00 am - FINAL Pool-play game against CREIGHTON PREP of Omaha -- at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo.

- The rest of Red's Sunday schedule -- will depend upon the outcome of games played in pool play on Friday through Sunday morning.
- Like Red, the other teams will be completing their final pool-play games at 10:00 am (or 12:30 pm.) Therefore, we may not know, until after all of those games are complete, whether or not we will be playing in the 3:00 pm championship game, which will match the winners of Pool A and Pool B against each other.
- If, after our 10:00 am game, we know for sure that we will not be playing at 3:00 pm, we will depart for home.
- If we have to wait for the 12:30 pm game to finish before we know, players can eat / spend time at local establishments and/or watch the game being played at 12:30 pm at Jack Williams (Fargo Post 2 vs Moorhead). In this case, all players must be present at Jack Williams by no later than 2:00 pm.

3:00 pm - As applicable, CHAMPIONSHIP GAME at Jack Williams Stadium in Fargo (with departure for home immediately afterward).

Additional Notes:

- ♦ Check the itinerary. ALWAYS BE ON TIME!
- ♦ Remember you represent yourself, your family, your coaches, your community, and the Legion.
- ♦ Any calls from the hotel staff about problems with any room (including noise) will result in disciplinary action against the entire room. Players are responsible for what happens in their rooms.
- ♦ There WILL be a gate fee for parents / spectators at each field. We are unsure, however, if they will be selling daily and/or full-tournament passes.
- ♦ We cannot guarantee that gate and/or concession stands will be accepting credit / debit cards. As such, please plan accordingly with respect to cash-on-hand!

Jim Pettersen FM Invitational 2023 Tournament Rules

1. All national American Legion Baseball senior rules are in effect, with the only exceptions listed below.
2. No time limits. Eight-run rule after 5 innings (or 4 ½ innings if home team leads by eight).
3. Extra innings begin with runner on 2nd base. The runner will be the last batter of the previous inning.
4. No re-entry. No courtesy runners. Please have a bench player ready to catch warmup pitches between innings.
5. DH is not mandatory, but if used, may only bat for the pitcher. The starting pitcher may also be the starting DH and use of this must be designated as P/DH on the official lineup card.
 - a. The DH is locked into the batting order. No multiple substitutions may be made that will alter the batting order of the DH.
 - b. If the P/DH is replaced as the pitcher, he may remain in the game in the role of the DH and may only bat in the DH spot.
 - c. If the P/DH is replaced as the DH, he may remain in the game as the pitcher. The new DH may only bat in the DH spot.
 - d. If a pinch hitter or pinch runner is substituted for the DH, that player becomes the new P/DH – or the new DH only – which must be declared at the time of the substitution.
 - e. The role of the DH is terminated for the remainder of the game when:
 - i. The pitcher bats for the DH or pinch-runs for the DH.
 - ii. The DH assumes a defensive position (except when the P/DH moves to DH only).
 - iii. The starting pitcher moves to any defensive position other than pitcher.
6. Site hosts will be always be home team for pool play games. Coin flip will determine home/away for all other pool play games and the championship game.
7. Base coaches are required to wear a standard batting helmet, with or without earflaps.
8. Non-wood bats must have BBCOR certification and maximum diameter of 2 5/8 inches.
9. All starters and all substitutes must be listed on team lineup cards.
10. American Legion pitching regulations are in effect, including pitch counts and days of rest.
11. Teams may take one 8-minute infield warmup prior to their first game of each day.
12. Tiebreaker criteria
 - a. Overall best win-loss record
 - b. Head-to-head record of teams involved in a tie
 - c. Least runs allowed (total of all games played in the tournament)
 - d. Most runs scored (total of all games played in the tournament)
 - e. Coin flip
13. In the event of rain or other unavoidable disruptions to play, the tournament director shall have full and final authority relative to scheduling and other tournament outcome decisions.
