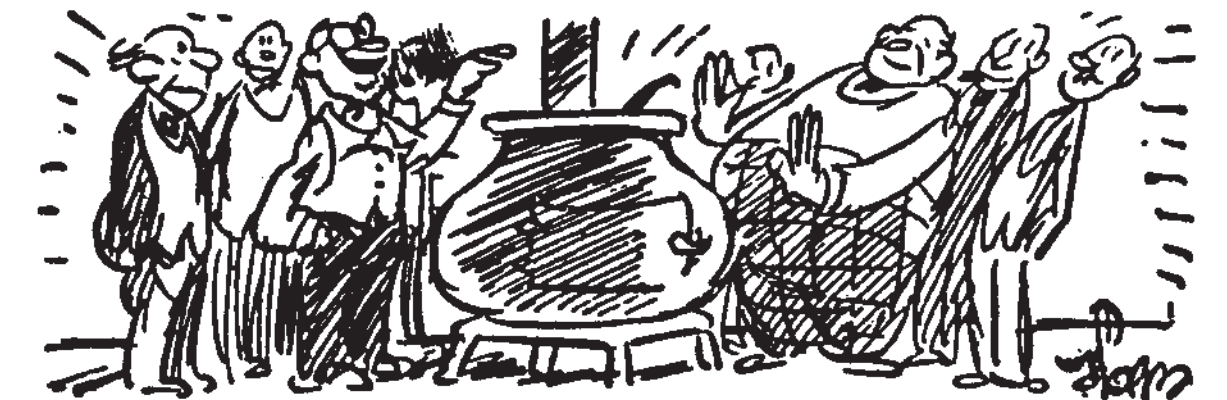

**2025 Honored Old Timer
 Norm Setnickler**

Norm was born in 1941 and raised in the Mesabi Iron Range town of Biwabik. He has played at all levels of baseball and softball, as well as having coached girls' softball for 20 years at Tartan High School. Norm's illustrious softball career includes winning eight National Tournament Championships, being a seven-time National All-Tournament award winner, as well as a three-time National Tournament MVP awardee. Still playing, he has been a participant in the Roseville Senior Softball League since 1997.

In 2008, Norm was inducted into the Minnesota Softball Coaches Hall of Fame, and in 2018, into the Minnesota Softball Hall of Fame. Additionally, he was inducted into the Minnesota Senior Sports Hall of Fame in 2023. At age 83, he continues to also play in the annual Old Timers Hot Stove League Charity Baseball Game, which benefits Our Lady of Peace Hospice in St. Paul as well as local youth baseball programs, such as American Legion Baseball.

Norm states that one of his favorite memories was playing in the Class B State Tournament for the Biwabik Chiefs town ball team in 1963 -- and winning two games. An exciting highlight was hitting three home runs in one game, against the Hibbing Greyhounds. Although Norm is a natural right-hand hitter, all three homers were from the left side of the plate. He is pretty sure that he impressed a supposed Chicago White Sox scout, who was rumored to be in the stands!

Norm's favorite memory of all was attending the Minnesota Twins Fantasy Camp in Fort Myers in 2014, at age 70. It was a surprise 50th wedding anniversary gift from his wife, Mary Ann. At the Camp, Norm was honored with the "Gold Glove" award -- as Best MVP Defensive Player over 50. Posing for a photograph with Bert Blyleven, Rod Carew and Tony Oliva was truly one of the most emotional experiences in his life.

Norm is most grateful for being able to play baseball and softball for over 70 years. As an ongoing participant in the Roseville Senior Softball Association, he continues to travel to major softball tournaments in the United States as well. Quoting former President Herbert Hoover (January 9, 1955), he states, "Next to religion, baseball has had a greater impact on our American way of life than any other American institution." Per Norm, it certainly has had a major impact on his life and the life of his family.
