Friday, June 27th

BY 12:30 pm, or earlier! - (recommended departure time by each carpool)

- Players should bring enough spending money for food, entertainment, shopping, etc.
- It is suggested that everyone who is driving to Fargo allow a good 4-5 hours, due to the normal annoyance of summer road construction projects -- and depending upon how often you plan to stop along the way.

11:30 pm - Room check by coaches. Players are to be in their respective rooms for the rest of the night

Saturday, June 28th

6:00 am - 10:00 am (hotel breakfast hours) - Players should eat breakfast and prepare to depart for first game.

 As an additional option, each room is scheduled to have a microwave and a mini-refrigerator. Thus, players could also purchase desired breakfast items at local establishments (for example, at nearby Hornbacher's Grocery Store) and refrigerating them overnight.

10:30 am - Room check by coaches, to ensure that all players are in the process of departing for the game site (car pools will then caravan to the ball park).

11:00 am (or earlier, as instructed) - Players must be present at the ball park for our first game of the day:

Noon - Pool-play game against HAMEL -- at Matson Field.

2:30 pm - Pool-play game against JAMESTOWN -- at Matson Field.

(Between the above two games, players may eat at the concession stand -- or, parents might wish to fetch take-out food from a nearby establishment.)

Following the games, players return to the hotel to change, shower, eat, etc. -- and enjoy free-time for the rest of the evening.

11:00 pm - Room check by coaches. Players are to be in their respective rooms for the rest of the night.

Sunday, June 30th

Sunday's schedule will depend upon our performance during pool play. Late Saturday night, <u>the Fargo tournament</u> <u>director will announce Sunday's game time</u> (either 9:30 am or NOON), <u>pairings</u>, and <u>assigned field location</u>.

Note: It is anticipated that all tournament game scores, as well as Sunday's schedule (when determined) will be posted on the Fargo Post 2 web site as well: <u>https://www.post2baseball.com/</u>

As such, players must be prepared to play at 9:30 am, if applicable. (If we are assigned a NOON game, the times below will be two-1/2 hours later, as noted):

6:30 am - 7:30 am (9-10 am, if assigned a Noon game) - Players should eat breakfast, <u>PACK UP ALL BELONGINGS and</u> <u>prepare for check-out</u> -- and departure for final game(s).

7:30 - 8:00 am (10-10:30 am, if assigned a Noon game) - Room check by coaches, to ensure that all players are in the process of departing for the game site (car pools will then caravan to the ball park).

8:30 am; or as instructed (11 am, if assigned a Noon game) - Players must be present at the assigned ball park for our designated game.

- If we know for sure that we will <u>not</u> be playing in the 2:30 pm championship game, we will depart for home after the game, otherwise
- If we are assigned to play at 9:30 am, win, and earn a berth in the championship game, we will have to wait for the Noon game to conclude, in order to learn our 2:30 pm opponent. Players can eat / spend time at local establishments and/or watch the game being played at Noon <u>at Jack Williams Stadium</u>. (If we are assigned to play at Noon, we will then play in the championship game immediately thereafter.) <u>Regardless, all players must be present at Jack Williams Stadium by no later than 1:30 pm.</u>
- **2:30 pm** CHAMPIONSHIP GAME at <u>Jack Williams Stadium</u> in Fargo (with departure for home immediately afterward).

Additional Notes:

- Check the itinerary. ALWAYS BE ON TIME!
- Remember you represent yourself, your family, your coaches, your community, and the American Legion.
- Tri-City Red has always been know for its positive sportsmanship and professionalism -- on and off the field. The entire TEAM (players, coaches, and family members) play a crucial role in maintaining that team culture!

 - NO RE-ENTRY, NO COURTESY RUNNERS.
 - American Legion pitch-count maximums apply.
 - Pool-play tie-breakers:
 - Overall best W/L record
 - Head-to-head record of teams involved in the tie
 - Least runs allowed, per inning
 - Most runs scored, per inning
 - Coin Flip
