- Note 1: League seed #8 is "home" in play-in game.
- Note 2: Highest league seed to emerge from play-in games is Team #8 for opening round of double-elimination.
- Note 3: Seeds #1-4 are "home" in the opening round in double-elimination. Team #1 will be home team until first loss. Highest league seed will be home team in all other games. Home teams will occupy 3rd base dugout for all games.
- Note 4: All games are nine (9) innings. 5 innings constitutes a complete game (4.5 if home team ahead), if called due to weather or other uncontrollable event. Before such, it is a suspended game to be resumed at the point it was stopped.
- Note 5: A 10-run rule applies after 7 innings (6.5 if the home team is ahead.)
- Note 6: DH is allowed for the pitcher only.
- Note 7: No courtesy runners are allowed for catchers or pitchers.
- Note 8: No re-entry of any players is permitted.
- Note 9: No player may pitch more than twelve (12) innings or make more than four (4) appearances as a pitcher in combining the total innings or appearances in any three (3) consecutive calendar-day period.
