

TRI-CITY RED "RAINS" SUPREME OVER ARCADE-PHALEN

Mounds View, Minn. (July 12) -- Tri-City Red won a shortened game against Arcade-Phalen on Thursday afternoon, in what was supposed to be a doubleheader against District 4 rival Arcade-Phalen. The game was stopped after the fifth inning due to impending weather and was officially called after the skies opened up and a deluge of rain landed on the field.

Red scored in four of their five at-bats, with the first two runs coming in the first, when Brett Bateman led off the game by reaching on an error by the shortstop. He advanced to second on a single from Carter Traczyk and scored on a single from Ben Jepko. Traczyk would also score, on a single off the bat of Justin Langer to put Red up 2-0.

After scoring one in the second, Red piled on the runs in the third inning, when Ike Mezzenga hit a two-out double. After Matt Herold was hit by a pitch, Hunter Ault delivered a sharp single to score Mezzenga. Jonah Sparks, who ran for Herold, scored on a single from Bateman, while Ault scored on a bases-loaded walk that was issued to John Solfest.

Red got a fantastic pitching performance from Scott Kalthoff, who threw all five innings, allowing no runs and just two hits to pick up his third win of the season.

The second game was postponed and will be rescheduled for a later date. Red will be back in action on Friday night when they travel to Irondale High School to face Tri-City Maroon, currently second in the league standings at 6-2, right behind Red (7-0). First pitch is scheduled for 6 p.m.
