

NORTH ST. PAUL, Minn. (June 20) -- Tri-City Red continued District 4 play with a 6-0 win over North St. Paul on Wednesday night at McKnight Field. Red was led by Ty Koehn, who pitched a complete game shutout, allowing three hits and recording nine strikeouts.

It was a slow start for Red offensively, as it took until the fourth inning for them to get on the board. The inning started when Carter Traczyk reached on an error by the first baseman and proceeded to steal second before advancing to third on a wild pitch. He scored when John Solfest singled. Solfest would score when Hunter Ault grounded out, while Ben Jepko reached on a single and scored on an error by the center fielder.

Red tacked on another run in the fifth when Brett Bateman singled, stole second and scored when Traczyk singled. They added a run in the sixth and seventh innings to beef up the lead.

Koehn was dominant on the mound, scattering just three hits. He picked up his first win of the season.

Red now gets a day off before returning to the diamond on Friday night when they open the Burnsville Snake Pit Tournament against Wayzata. First pitch is at 7:00 pm at Burnsville's Alimagnet Park Field No. 2.
