MATT HEROLD GRAND SLAM LEADS TRI-CITY RED PAST PARK RIVER ON DAY TWO OF FM INVITATIONAL

Moorhead, Minn. (June 29) -- Matt Herold hit a grand slam in the bottom of the sixth inning to spur Tri-City Red to a 10-3 win over Park River (ND) on Saturday afternoon. The game was called in the top of the sixth inning due to an incoming storm.

It was a slow start for Red; through the fourth inning Red had no runs, and only two hits, and Park River led the Red crew by a score of 3-0.

In the fifth, however, Red bats woke up. It started with Jonah Sparks drawing a one-out walk. He scored when Ike Mezzenga ripped a triple to left-center field, cutting the Park River lead to 3-1. Mezzenga then scored on a wild pitch to make it 3-2.

Each of the next three batters walked to load the bases for Matt Herold, who made a pinchhitting appearance. He took the second pitch he saw and deposited it over the left field fence for a grand slam, to push Red into the lead, 6-3.

Red continued the scoring in the top half of the sixth, as Brett Bateman led off with a single, before advancing to third on two consecutive wild pitches. Sparks and Mezzenga both drew walks to load the bases for Channing Cole, who drove in three runs with a single; he took second on the throw home. Cole Stenstrom then singled, to move Cole to third. A sacrifice fly by Ben Kettelhut scored Cole, to put Red into double digits, leading 10-4.

After the first Park River batter grounded out in the bottom of the sixth, the game was called by the umpires, when a large flash of lightning and clap of thunder occurred overhead. Being beyond the fifth inning, it constituted a complete game, with Red being the victor.

Trevor Rankin picked up the win, going the first four innings and allowing only 4 hits and one walk. Cole Stenstrom pitched the final one and one-third inning, chalking up two strike outs and allowing no hits, before the game was called.

The ensuing severe storm and heavy rain made the fields at Matson and Jack Williams unplayable for the rest of the day; thus, the tournament schedule was revised, in an effort to give each team at least four games, total, for the weekend. As such, Red will wrap up the Fargo-Moorhead Invitational at 1 p.m. Sunday against the Moorhead Blues. The game will be played at Bucky Burgau Field on the campus of Concordia College in Moorhead. (Play at Young Field in West Fargo, which has a turf infield, was expected to resume on Saturday night; leaving that field available on Sunday for rescheduled Jack Williams pool games.)
