TRI-CITY RED DEFEATS MOORHEAD, EARNS FM INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP



Moorhead, Minn. (June 30) -- Tri-City Red took home a 5-1 win over the Moorhead Blues on Sunday afternoon at Matson Field, to finish the FM Invitational undefeated. Tournament organizers awarded Red the tournament championship, due to Red having allowed less total runs (11) than the other two pool winners. Fargo won the Jack Williams pool (4-0, 12 total runs allowed), and Sioux Falls won the Young Field pool (4-0, 20 total runs allowed).

It didn't take long for Red to get the scoring started against Moorhead, as in the top of the first, Brett Bateman doubled to start the game -- before advancing to third on a fly out from Jonah Sparks. After John Solfest worked a walk, Bateman scored on a wild pitch, to put Red up 1-0.

After Moorhead tied the game in the bottom of the fourth, Red turned up the heat in the top of the sixth. Isaac Mezzenga drew a one-out walk to start things off, and he advanced to third on a double from Carter Traczyk. Both Mezzenga and Traczyk then scored on a single from Channing Cole, to open up another Red lead, 3-1.

Cole Stenstrom then doubled, before advancing to third, when Matt Herold reached on a fielder's choice at home plate. Stenstrom scored on a throwing error by the pitcher to third base, to push the lead to 4-1.

Red added an insurance run in the seventh; Bateman doubled to lead off the inning, before advancing to third on a wild pitch. He scored when Mezzenga grounded out to the pitcher.

Mezzenga, in addition to his RBI, got the start on the mound, going four and two-thirds of an inning, and allowing three hits and one run. He gave way in the fifth to Cole Stenstrom, who slammed the door shut to pick up the win.

Red now gets the week off due to the Fourth of July before returning to action after the holiday.
