RED WALKS-OFF INTO SEMIFINALS OF BURNSVILLE TOURNAMENT

Burnsville, Minn. (June 21) -- Tri-City Red won two games on Saturday (both being walk-offs) at the Burnsville Snake Pit Tournament to win Pool A and advance to the tournament semifinals. (Red's Sunday game time and opponent will be determined later tonight, after the final games are concluded.)

In game one, Red won 11-3 over Chaska. Red had two high-scoring innings, starting in the fourth when Ben Kettelhut drew a leadoff walk. He advanced to third before scoring on a three-RBI double off the bat of Jonah Sparks -- that also scored Mitchell Gutzkow (who was running for Matt Herold) and Sean Goldman.

Red added four more runs in the sixth, including a two-RBI double from Kettelhut and a walkoff single from Herold -- that scored Channing Cole to win the game via the eight-run rule, per this tournament's rules.

Red was up 8-2 in the sixth, when John Solfest stepped to the plate and singled. The next batter was Rogers, who hit a no-doubt-about-it home run over the left-center field fence, which scored Solfest and ended the game -- again via the eight-run rule.

Trevor Rankin got the start on the mound, pitching four innings with one hit and one run. He was relieved by Ben Kettelhut, who went two innings with three hits and one run, picking up the win.

Red will be back in action on Sunday afternoon, with the time and opponent to be determined following the conclusion of tonight's games.
